

ID Requirements - South Australia

It is a requirement of law that:

1 item must have a current residential address;

1 item has a full name and signature, and

1 item must be of government issue.

Identification source - must be one of the below two options

Option 1

A single card or document issued by Government or Statutory Authority which contains:

- Full name
- States current residential address
- A signature
- A photograph of the applicant

Drivers license or SA Proof of Age card meet these requirements

Option 2

Two or more documents issued by Government or Statutory Authority of the state or the Commonwealth or another state or territory which:

- 1 item issued by the Government or Statutory Authority
- 1 item with full name
- 1 item that states current residential address
- 1 item with a signature

The below items are examples of documentation that meet **option 2**.

Gas, Phone, etc Bills (max 2)

Financial Body Statement (max 2)

ATM Card (max 2 different banks)

Electoral Roll (current year)

Public Service Employee Card (current)

Employment Card/Statement (current)

Tertiary Education Certificate

Marriage Certificate

Medicare Card (no temporary)

Trade/Union Card (current)

Rates (house)

Car Registration Certificate (current)

Securities Mortgage Certificate

Certificate of Land Title

Health Care Card

Pension Concession Card

Seniors Card

Employment Card (current)

Rental Agreement (current)
