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Valuation for Traditional Retail Replacement

Item 1

One, lady's, raised 9ct yellow gold and diamond set, multistone ring, of cast construction Plain, narrow, low half round, tapered band, measures 2.21mm width (at base) x 0.79mm depth, with open back, underneath.

Feature "solitaire style" ring design, with shoulder stones, comprising, one raised central setting, housing one round brilliant cut diamond, rub-over set. The extended shoulders, of the band, both sides, taper up to the top, to a wrap each side of the central setting. Each shoulder contains three round brilliant cut diamonds, channel set, both sides.

Polished finish, stamped "9ct" - acid tested as 9 carat gold. Finger size = N3/4.

The ring contains;

One rub over set round brilliant cut diamond, clarity is "Si", colour is "I", medium cut quality.
Dimensions = 3.20mm (Diameter) x 1.95mm (D-estimated)
Total Weight = 0.12ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Six channel set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Si & P1"(mixed), colour is "H to I"(mixed), medium cut quality.
Dimensions = 1.40mm (Diameter) x 0.85mm (D-estimated)
Total Weight = 0.06ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Total Item Weight = 2.40 grams, Total Gemstone Weight = 0.18ct, Total Metal Weight = 2.36 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the setting. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail replacement purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
