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Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, 9ct yellow gold and 9ct white gold, gem set, 'cluster' style ring, of hand-assembled construction.

Plain, narrow, low half round band of 2.63mm width (at base) x 0.87mm depth, with a hollow top and shoulders, open back settings, and a cut out curved underrail.

Feature pear shaped top plate, with seven white gold illusion settings, to the centre, each housing one round brilliant cut diamond, illusion set. The surround and shoulders house a total of fifty-four round brilliant cut diamonds, claw set. Each of the shoulders also house one inner row of ten baguette cut diamonds, graduating in size, and channel set. The top plate is secured to the 'split' style shoulders, of the plain and polished band.

Polished finish. Unstamped - acid tested as 9 carat gold. Ring size: O.

The ring contains:

Six illusion set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "P2 & P3" (mixed), colour is "H to I" (mixed).

Dimensions = 2.20mm(Dia) x 1.34mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 2.45mm(Dia) x 1.49mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.27ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Fifty Four claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "P2 & P3" (mixed), colour is "H to I" (mixed).

Dimensions = 1.40mm(Dia) x 0.85mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 1.60mm(Dia) x 0.98mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.70ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Twenty channel set baguette cut diamonds, clarity is "Si & P1 & P2" (mixed), colour is "H to I" (mixed).

Dimensions = 1.45mm(L) x 0.87mm(W) x 0.64mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 1.72mm(L) x 1.08mm(W) x 0.79mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.28ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 4.95 grams Total Gemstone Weight = 1.25ct Total Metal Weight = 4.70 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
