Item 1

One, 18ct white gold, multi-stone, ring set, of handmade construction.

The set comprising a 18ct white gold diamond set engagement ring with a matching 18ct white gold wedding ring. Each ring having a plain, narrow, low half round band with a combined basal width of 4.68mm x 1.54mm in depth.

The engagement ring has a decorative four claw setting, housing one Princess cut diamond, claw set. The setting is secured between the extended and pointed shoulders of the plain and polished band.



The matching wedding ring, is a plain and polished band. The wedding ring sits alongside the engagement ring above.

Polished finish. Stamped '18ct Imp 19(engagement) 750(wedding)' - acid tested as '18 carat gold. Ring size: K 1/2.

The ring set contains:

One claw set Princess cut diamond, clarity is "Vs2", colour is "E".

Dimensions = 5.79mm(L) x 5.71mm(W) x 4.23mm(D-estimated) x 4%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 1.23ct (known weight - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 6.58 grams Total Gemstone Weight = 1.23ct Total Metal Weight = 6.33 grams (estimated)

NOTE: The diamond has been certified by Messrs. Gemological Institute of America (GIA) Certificate number: 6127445529 Dated: August 06, 2010. The diamond has also been laser inscribed upon the girdle with GIA (logo) and 6127445529. Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstone cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weight of the gemstone is very much an estimation. For an accurate weight, colour, and clarity grading, the gemstone requires removal from the setting. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring set employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
