Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, hand-finished (CAD - Cad Aided Design), raised 18ct white gold & gemset, multistone ring. Plain, wide, flat, low half round, tapered band, measures 6.04mm width (at base) x 1.65mm depth, with curved underrail, open spaced at top. Feature; 'split rail design'. Comprising, three claw set rails to each side. Center rails both having a four claw setting at end houses one oval-shaped, faceted natural emerald (total x 2), claw set. Two outer rails, each contain two round brilliant cut diamonds (total x 4), claw set, ends. The six rows containing a total of fifty six round brilliant cut diamonds, all claw set, both sides.



Polished finish, stamped "750, SHANNAKIAN" - acid tested as 18 carat gold. Finger size L.

The ring contains;

Two claw set oval-shaped, faceted, natural emeralds, colour is "medium dark green".
Ave dimensions = 5.82mm (L) x 4.01mm (W) x 3.04mm (D-estimated) (smallest)
Ave dimensions = 6.05mm (L) x 4.03mm (W) x 2.65mm (D-estimated) (largest)
Total Weight = 0.70ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Four claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Vs & Si"(mixed), colour is "G to H"(mixed), medium cut quality.
Dimensions = 2.34mm (ave diameter) x 1.43mm (D-estimated) (smallest)
Dimensions = 2.83mm (ave diameter) x 1.73mm (D-estimated) (largest)
Total Weight = 0.26ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Fifty Six claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Si & P1"(mixed), colour is "G to H"(mixed), medium cut quality.
Dimensions = 1.19mm (ave diameter) x 0.73mm (D-estimated) (smallest)
Dimensions = 1.24mm (ave diameter) x 0.76mm (D-estimated) (largest)
Total Weight = 0.28ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Total Item Weight = 6.99 grams, Total Gemstone Weight = 1.24ct, Total Metal Weight = 6.74 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Limited gemmological testing, inset, The natural emeralds are heavily included & one has a conchoidal fracture to one corner. Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
