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### Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

#### Item 1

One, 18ct white gold, multistone, gem set ring, of cast construction. Plain, narrow band of 1.70mm in width (at base) x 1.60mm depth, with open back setting.

Feature central four claw setting, housing one round brilliant cut diamond, claw set. Surrounded by two stepped down rows, also claw set with a total of thirty-eight round brilliant cut diamonds, tapering in size to smallest. The setting base being of a multi 'leaf' style, all secured between the 'ramp' style shoulders of the plain and polished band. Each shoulder having eight round brilliant cut diamonds, claw set.



Polished finish - stamped '750 RAND' - acid tested as 18 carat gold. Finger size is K 1/2.

The ring contains:

One claw set round brilliant cut diamond, clarity 'Si1', colour 'F'.  
Dimensions = 4.41mm(L) x 4.39mm(W) x 2.76mm(D-estimated) x 3.5%(Girdle Thickness)  
Total Weight = 0.32ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Fifty Four claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity 'Si', colour 'yellow & H to I' (mixed).  
Dimensions = 0.90mm to 1.15mm(Dia) x 0.61mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness)  
Total Weight = 0.23ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 3.31 grams - Total Gemstone Weight = 0.55ct - Total Metal Weight = 3.20 grams (estimated)

NOTE: The centre diamond is laser inscribed with the GIA (logo) and 2186574865. No diamond certificate or paperwork was presented at the time of this valuation. Unsetting for verification would be required. Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the remaining diamonds cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the remaining diamonds are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the remaining diamonds require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
