Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, 14ct white gold, gem set, multistone ring, of cast construction.

Plain, narrow, low half round, tapered band of 2.31mm width (at base) x 0.65mm depth, with open back settings, and a curved underrail.

Feature central four claw setting, created with the upswept 'split' style shoulders, housing one laser drilled and fracture filled radiant cut diamond, claw set. Each of the shoulders house one row of five round brilliant cut diamonds, bead set. The shoulders extend out from the plain and polished band.

Polished finish.

Stamped '585' - acid tested as 14 carat gold.

Ring size: M.

The ring contains:

One claw set laser drilled and fracture filled radiant cut diamond.

Dimensions = 6.02mm(L) x 5.91mm(W) x 3.70mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 1.06ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Ten bead set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "P1 & P2" (mixed), colour is "G to H" (mixed).

Dimensions (average) = 1.35mm(Dia) x 0.82mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 0.11ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 2.42 grams Total Gemstone Weight = 1.17ct Total Metal Weight = 2.19 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the diamond cannot be ascertained. Therefore, the weight of the diamond is very much an estimation. The diamond has been enhanced by means of filling with a glass type substance. This treatment is not stable and can be damaged by heat or ultrasonic frequencies. Due to this filling, colour and clarity gradings have not been assigned. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques with a fractured filled diamond of similar appearance being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item. The weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
