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Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, hand-assembled, platinum and white gold, 'solitaire', diamond set ring.

Plain, narrow, reverse tapered band of 2.80mm in width (at base) x 1.12mm depth, with a curved underrail.

Feature 'solitaire' style ring design, consisting of a two claw, one 'V' claw, railed setting, housing one pear-shape brilliant cut diamond, claw set. Secured between the extended shoulders of the plain and polished band.

Polished finish.

Stamped 'PLAT 18CT & partial stamp' - acid tested.

Finger size is H 1/2, with a 'comfort fit' style inner curve.

The ring contains:

One claw set pear-shape brilliant cut diamond, clarity 'Vs2', colour 'G'.

Dimensions = 7.10mm(L) x 4.62mm(W) x 2.57mm(D-estimated) x 2.5%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 0.50ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 3.34 grams

Total Gemstone Weight = 0.50ct

Total Metal Weight = 3.24 grams (estimated)

NOTE: The diamond has been laser inscribed upon the girdle with Antwerp Certified HRD (logo) and 06008812009. No diamond certificate or paperwork was presented at the time of this valuation. Due to setting constraints, the diamond would require unsetting for the exact dimensions. Therefore, the weight of the diamond is very much an estimation. For an accurate weight, colour, and clarity grading, the diamond requires removal from the setting. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
