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## Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

### Item 1

One, hand-assembled raised, 18ct yellow gold & 9ct yellow gold, diamond set, necklet. Feature; " ornate fixed cross over feature to front. One side, having a railed, single row channel setting, broken with a square-shaped box setting on top. To the opposite side a split v-shaped double row, with a double v-shaped channel row, with a triangular-shaped beaded setting to front. The ornate feature, is open to back underneath. Suspended from each end, a flexible herring bone style flat link chain, with a 9ct parrot clasp closure attached.



Polished finish, stamped "750, MD star 298" - acid tested as 18 carat gold, & 9ct gold.

Necklet (chain) dimensions = 42.00cm (length) x 4.76mm (width) x 1.45mm (depth).

Centre peice dimensions = 60.00mm (length) x 4.90-7.90mm (width) x 2.96mm - 8.00mm (depth).

The necklet contains:

Ten channel set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "P1, P2 & P3"(mixed), colour is "H to I"(mixed), medium cut quality.

Dimensions = 2.60mm (average diameter) x 1.59mm (D-estimated) (smallest)

Dimensions = 3.50mm (average diameter) x 2.14mm (D-estimated) (largest)

Total Weight = 1.10ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Eighteen channel set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "P1 & P2"(mixed), colour is "H to I"(mixed), medium cut quality.

Dimensions = 1.90mm (average diameter) x 1.16mm (D-estimated) (smallest)

Dimensions = 3.10mm (average diameter) x 1.89mm (D-estimated) (largest)

Total Weight = 1.40ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Fifty Six bead set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "P1, P2 & P3"(mixed), colour is "H to I"(mixed), medium cut quality.

Dimensions = 1.69mm (average diameter) x 1.03mm (D-estimated) (smallest)

Dimensions = 2.50mm (average diameter) x 1.53mm (D-estimated) (largest)

Total Weight = 2.50ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Total Item Weight = 35.28 grams, Total Gemstone Weight = 5.00ct, Total Metal Weight = 34.28 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Limited gemmological testing, inset. Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the diamond cannot be ascertained Therefore, weight of the diamond are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the diamond would require removal from the setting. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar necklet employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
