Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One set of, 18ct yellow gold and 18ct white gold, gem set rings, of cast construction.

Pain, flat band of 7.40mm width (at base) x 1.64mm depth, with open back settings.

Feature one yellow gold band, interlocking with a white gold band. Both of the bands have an asymmetrical arrangement, of a total of sixteen round brilliant cut diamonds, graduating in size, and gypsy set. The settings are secured between the shoulders of the plain and polished bands.

Polished finish.

Stamped '51 NK 750 DENMARK GEORG JENSEN' - acid tested 18 carat gold.

Ring Size: M.

The ring contains:

Sixteen gypsy set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Vs & Si" (mixed), colour is "G to H" (mixed).

Dimensions = 1.50mm(Dia) x 0.92mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 2.20mm(Dia) x 1.34mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.43ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 9.99 grams Total Gemstone Weight = 0.43ct Total Metal Weight = 9.90 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The ring set has a stamp of Georg Jensen upon - however, George Jensen will need to assist with authenticating whether or not the ring set is of their supply. Therefore, the below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring set employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
