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Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, 18ct yellow gold, gem set, 'cluster' style ring, of cast construction.

Plain, narrow, low half round band of 1.55mm width (at base) x 0.92mm depth, with open back settings, and a curved underrail.

Feature central cluster of nine oval natural opal cabochons, claw set. Interspersed between these settings, are twelve claw settings, each housing one single cut diamond, claw set. The settings are secured to the underrail, and in between the split shoulders, of the plain and polished band. The settings have been embellished with a 'bark' style texture.

Polished finish.

Stamped '750' - Hallmarked in London, England, 1975 - acid tested as 18 carat gold.

Ring size: N 1/2.

The ring contains:

Eight claw set oval natural opal cabochons, with "green, blue, yellow" play of colours.

Dimensions = 5.81mm(L) x 3.89mm(W) x 2.15mm(D-estimated)

Total Weight = 2.16ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Twelve claw set single cut diamonds, clarity is "Vs & Si & P1" (mixed), colour is "G to I" (mixed).

Dimensions (average) = 1.90mm(diameter)

Total Weight = 0.32ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 6.25gm Total Gemstone Weight = 2.48ct Total Metal Weight = 5.75 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The replacement figure below is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
