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## Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

### Item 1

One, cast & hand finished, raised, 18ct white gold & diamond set, ring. Plain, narrow, low half round, tapered band, measures 1.93mm width (at base) x 1.03mm depth, with underrail, open back settings, underneath.

Feature; "solitaire style" design with shoulder stones. Comprising, a raised four claw setting to centre, houses one round brilliant cut diamond (certified & laser inscribed), claw set. The extended shoulders, of the band tapers up to the top. Each shoulder contains, seven round brilliant cut diamonds (total x 14), bead set, from both sides.

Polished finish, stamped "750, 70 40 (partial) - acid tested as 18 carat gold. Finger size = 11/2.

The ring contains;

One claw set round brilliant cut diamond, clarity is "Si2", colour is "D", Excellent cut quality.  
Dimensions = 4.86 - 4.89mm (average diameter) x 2.98mm (D-actual) x 3.5%(Girdle Thickness)  
Total Weight = 0.43ct (known weight - see NOTE below).

Fourteen bead set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Vs & Si"(mixed), colour is "G", good cut quality.  
Dimensions = 1.15mm (average diameter) x 0.70mm (D-estimated) (smallest)  
Dimensions = 1.20mm (average diameter) x 0.73mm (D-estimated) (largest)  
Total Weight = 0.07ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Total Item Weight = 2.29 grams, Total Gemstone Weight = 0.50ct, Total Metal Weight = 2.19 grams (estimated)

NOTE: The round brilliant cut diamond, has been certified by, and is the opinion of, Messrs. Gemological Institute of America. Certificate no.2146172474. Dated October, 23, 2012. The diamond has also been laser inscribed upon the girdle with GIA (logo) and 2146172474. Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the other diamonds, cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the other diamonds, are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the other diamonds, would require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
