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### Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

#### Item 1

One, hand-assembled, 9ct yellow gold & 22ct yellow gold, gemset, flexible link pendant/necklet.

Feature; "1/2 sovereign type coin medallion to centre". Comprising, a 9ct disc pendant with rhodium plated side collars, to the top, a single bead set row of round brilliant cut diamonds. To the bottom a plain fluted groove. From the top a fixed enhancer bail clip attached. Suspended from a solid, 9ct flexible belcher link chain, with a parrot clasp closure.

Polished finish, stamped "375, 375" (chain & holder) - acid tested & x-rayed.

Necklet dimensions = 66.00cm (total length inclusive) x 3.52mm (width) x 3.52mm (depth).  
Pendant dimensions = 35.00mm (length) x 27.00mm (width) x 4.53mm (depth).

Medallion 1/2 sovereign type coin. Reverse; GEORGE V (head of Monarch - King George the fifth, facing left). (B.M).

GEORGIVS V D.G. BRITT : OMN : REX F.D. IND: IMP:

Obverse stamp; St George on horse back, sword in hand & slain dragon. (B.P). Dated 1913.

The pendant contains:

Sixteen bead set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Si & P1"(mixed), colour is "G to H"(mixed), medium cut quality.  
Dimensions = 1.43mm (average diameter) x 0.87mm (D-estimated)  
Total Weight = 0.18ct (estimated - see NOTE below).

Total Item Weight = 23.01grams.

NOTE: Limited gemmological testing, inset. Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the diamonds cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weight of the diamonds are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the diamond would require removal from the setting. The coin has been x-rayed to confirm its gold authenticity, and is presumed to be genuine. The below replacement figure is based upon the coin being gold content and spot price of the day, what would be paid for a similar coin similar condition, and the coin frame pendant/necklet based upon crafting a similar coin frame pendant/necklet employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
