Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, 18ct yellow gold, gem set, 'cluster' style ring, of cast construction.

Plain, narrow, low half round band of 1.60mm width (at base) x 0.93mm depth, with open back settings, and a curved underrail.

Feature central row of three round brilliant cut diamonds, and a cluster of three round brilliant cut diamonds, to the top and the bottom, graduating in size, largest to the centre, all claw set. To one side, is one row of three marquise cut natural rubies, and to the other side, is two marquise cut rubies and one marquise cut glass (paste) type material, claw set. The settings are secured to the underrail, and in between the extended and pointed shoulders, of the plain and polished band.

Polished finish. Stamped ('51101(scratch)' - acid tested as 18 carat gold. Ring size: P.

The ring contains:

Nine claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Si & P1 & P2" (mixed), colour is "G to H" (mixed).

Dimensions = 2.26mm(Dia) x 1.38mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 2.60mm(Dia) x 1.59mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.43ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Five claw set marquise natural rubies, colour is "red".

Dimensions = 5.25mm(L) x 2.85mm(W) x 1.74mm(D-estimated)

Total Weight = 0.95ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

One claw set marquise synthetic glass (paste) type material, colour is "red".

Dimensions = 5.25mm(L) x 2.85mm(W) x 1.74mm(D-estimated)

Total Weight = 0.01ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 4.35 grams Total Gemstone Weight = 1.39ct Total Metal Weight = 4.07 grams (estimated)

NOTE: There is significant abrasion and fractures to glass (paste) type material. Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
