Item 1

One, 9ct yellow gold and rhodium plated, gem set, 'cluster' style ring, of cast construction.

Plain, narrow, low half round band of 2.33mm width (at base) x 1.03mm depth, with a curved underrail.

Feature cushion shaped top plate, housing nine round brilliant cut diamonds, to the centre, graduating in size, and claw set. The double surround and shoulders houses a total of seventy-four round brilliant cut diamonds, all claw set. The top plate is secured to the underrail, and in between the tapering shoulders, of the plain and polished band. Rhodium plating to the diamond setting areas.

Polished finish.

Stamped '9K 1.00CT' - acid tested as 9 carat gold.

Ring size: O.

The ring contains:

Eighty Three claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "P1 & P2" (mixed), colour is "light tinted brown to brown tint".
Dimensions = 1.35mm(Dia) x 0.82mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)
Dimensions = 2.45mm(Dia) x 1.49mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)
Total Weight = 1.00ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 5.48 grams
Total Gemstone Weight = 1.00ct
Total Metal Weight = 5.28 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
