### Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

#### Item 1

One, 18ct white gold, gem set, multistone ring, of hand-assembled construction.

Plain, narrow, low half round band of 1.96mm width (at base) x 0.82mm depth, with open back settings, and a curved underrail.

Feature central double bezel setting, housing one Princess cut diamond, bezel set. Surrounding is one row of four baguette cut diamonds, end set. The setting is secured to the extended and square shoulders, of the plain and polished band. Each of the shoulders houses one row of six Princess cut diamonds, graduating in size, and channel set.



Polished finish. Unstamped - acid tested as 18 carat gold. Ring size: R.

#### The ring contains:

One bezel set Princess cut diamond, clarity is "Vs", colour is "G".

Dimensions = 3.49mm(L) x 3.49mm(W) x 2.48mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 0.22ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Four end set baguette cut diamonds, clarity is "Vs", colour is "G to H" (mixed).

Dimensions (average) = 3.00mm(L) x 1.50mm(W) x 1.10mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 0.24ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Twelve channel set Princess cut diamonds, clarity is "Vs & Si & P1 & P2" (mixed), colour is "G to H" (mixed).

Dimensions = 1.50mm(L) x 1.50mm(W) x 1.06mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 2.60mm(L) x 2.60mm(W) x 1.85mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

Total Weight = 0.72ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 3.01 grams Total Gemstone Weight = 1.18ct Total Metal Weight = 2.77 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
