Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, hand assembled 18ct white gold, multi-stone, ring set, of cast construction.

The set comprising a 18ct white gold diamond set engagement ring with matching 18ct white gold diamond set wedding and eternity ring. Each ring having a plain, narrow, low half round, tapered band with a combined basal width of 8.60mm x 1.57mm in depth.

The engagement ring has a central six claw setting, housing one round brilliant cut diamond, claw set. The setting is secured to the underrail, and in between the 'ramp' style shoulders of the plain and polished band. Each of the shoulders houses one row of five round brilliant cut diamonds, claw set. The matching wedding and eternity rings are identical. One row of nine round brilliant cut diamonds, varying slightly in size, and claw set. The settings are secured between the shoulders of the plain and polished band. The wedding and eternity rings sit alongside the engagement ring above.



Polished finish. Stamped '750 Salera's 3(engagement) SJ 18K(wedding and eternity rings) - acid tested as 18 carat gold. Ring size: P 1/2.

The ring set contains:

One claw set round brilliant cut diamond, clarity is "P1", colour is "F".

Dimensions = 6.60mm(L) x 6.54mm(W) x 3.91mm(D-estimated)

Total Weight = 1.05ct (known weight - see NOTE below)

Twenty Eight claw set round brilliant cut diamonds, clarity is "Si & P1" (mixed), colour is "H to J" (mixed).

Dimensions = 1.64mm(Dia) x 1.00mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (smallest)

Dimensions = 3.05mm(Dia) x 1.86mm(D-estimated) x 2%(Girdle Thickness) (largest)

Total Weight = 2.18ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 11.89 grams Total Gemstone Weight = 3.23ct Total Metal Weight = 11.24 grams (estimated)

NOTE: The diamond has been certified by and is the opinion of Messrs. International Gemological Institute, Certificate no. 151576540 Dated February 127, 2015. The diamond has also been laser inscribed upon the girdle with IGI (logo) and 151576540. Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring set employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. The figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
