Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

Item 1

One, 14ct yellow gold, gem set, 'solitaire' style ring, of cast construction.

Plain, narrow, low half round band of 3.22mm width (at base) x 1.92mm depth.

Feature central bezel setting, housing one round brilliant cut diamond, bezel set. The setting is secured to the top of the plain and polished band.

Polished finish.

Stamped '585 RUUSK' - acid tested as 14 carat gold.

Ring size: L.

The ring contains:

One bezel set round brilliant cut diamond, clarity is "Vs1", colour is "G".

Dimensions = 5.79mm(L) x 5.76mm(W) x 3.61mm(D-estimated) x 4.5%(Girdle Thickness)

Total Weight = 0.75ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 5.76 grams

Total Gemstone Weight = 0.75ct

Total Metal Weight = 5.61 grams (estimated)

NOTE: The diamond was accompanied with a diamond certificate by Messrs. Gemological Institute of America (GIA) Certificate number: 1216226120 Dated: October 28, 2020, indicating that the diamond has also been laser inscribed upon the girdle with GIA (logo) and 1216226120. Due to setting constraints, the inscription cannot be viewed and the exact dimensions of the diamond cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weight of the diamond is very much an estimation. For certificate verification, accurate weight, colour, and clarity grading, the diamond requires removal from the setting. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
