## Valuation for Traditional Retail Insurance Replacement

### Item 1

One, 18ct yellow gold and 18ct white gold, gem set, 'dress' style ring, of hand-assembled construction.

Plain, narrow, flat band of 2.70mm width (at base) x 0.91mm depth, with a curved underrail.

Feature central white gold four claw setting, housing one round natural opal cabochon, claw set. Either side of the central setting, is one four claw setting, each housing one round brilliant cut diamond, claw set. The settings are secured to the underrail, and in between the shoulders of the plain and polished yellow gold band.

Polished finish.

Stamped '18CT PAL-PLAT' - acid tested as 18 carat gold.

Ring size: N.

The ring contains:

One claw set round natural opal cabochon, with "green, blue, yellow" play of colours.

Dimensions = 7.31mm(L) x 7.18mm(W) x 3.02mm(D-estimated)

Total Weight = 0.95ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Two claw set single cut diamonds, clarity is "Si", colour is "H to I" (mixed).

Dimensions (average) = 2.00mm(diameter)

Total Weight = 0.06ct (estimated - see NOTE below)

Total Item Weight = 3.60 grams Total Gemstone Weight = 1.01ct Total Metal Weight = 3.40 grams (estimated)

NOTE: Due to setting constraints, the exact dimensions of the gemstones cannot be ascertained. Therefore, weights of the gemstones are very much estimated. For accurate testing, weights, colour, and clarity gradings, the gemstones require removal from the settings. The below replacement figure is based upon crafting a similar ring employing similar materials and techniques being for a retail insurance purpose only. This figure does not represent the previous selling price of the item and will not be indicative of the resale value of the item.
